For the local communities affected by situations of abuse, for families and friends of the victims for the families and friends of the abusers, for parish communities shocked and hurt, that disbelief will give way to trust, that anger will give way to hope.

Lord, in your mercy.

R^X. Hear our prayer.

For the whole church, that truth will set us free, that healing will restore our lives, that we will break the cycle of abuse.

Lord, in your mercy.

R^Z Hear our prayer.

That throughout the whole world whatever is weak may be strengthened, whatever is broken restored, whatever is lost found,

and what is sinful redeemed.

Lord, in your mercy.

R[×] Hear our prayer.

Concluding Prayer

O God, in whose enduring love we trust, bind up the wounds of those abused. Heal them and make them whole, that they may once more receive and give love with confidence in their dignity as your sons and daughters.

We ask this through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God for ever and ever.
