Lent

- c. Glory to you, O Christ, you are the Word of God.
- d. Glory to you, O Christ, Son of the living God.
- e. Praise and honour to you, Lord Jesus.
- f. Praise to you, O Christ, King of eternal glory.
- g. Great and wonderful are your works, O Lord.
- h. Salvation, glory, and power belong to the Lord Jesus Christ.

In the text which follows an acclamation has been given for each week of Lent. This may be replaced by one of the other acclamations.
